

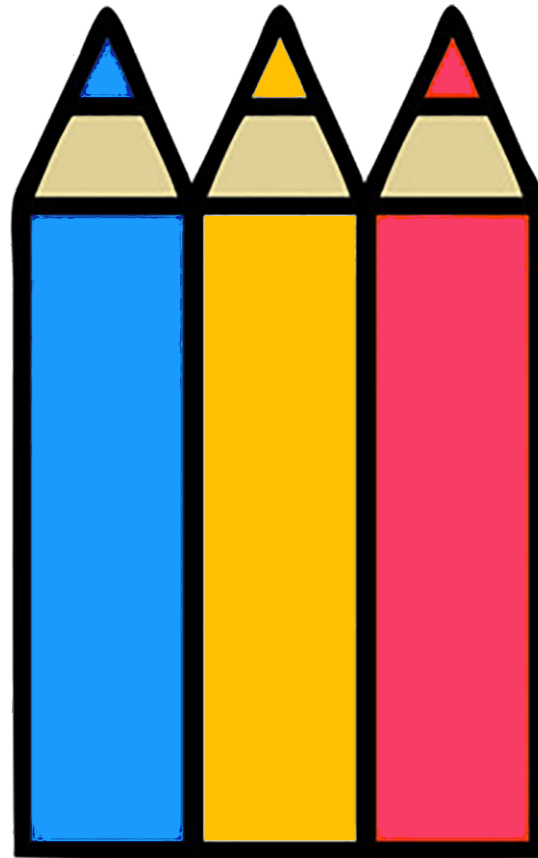

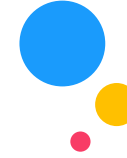

- Systematic review of the summary at the beginning of the next course.

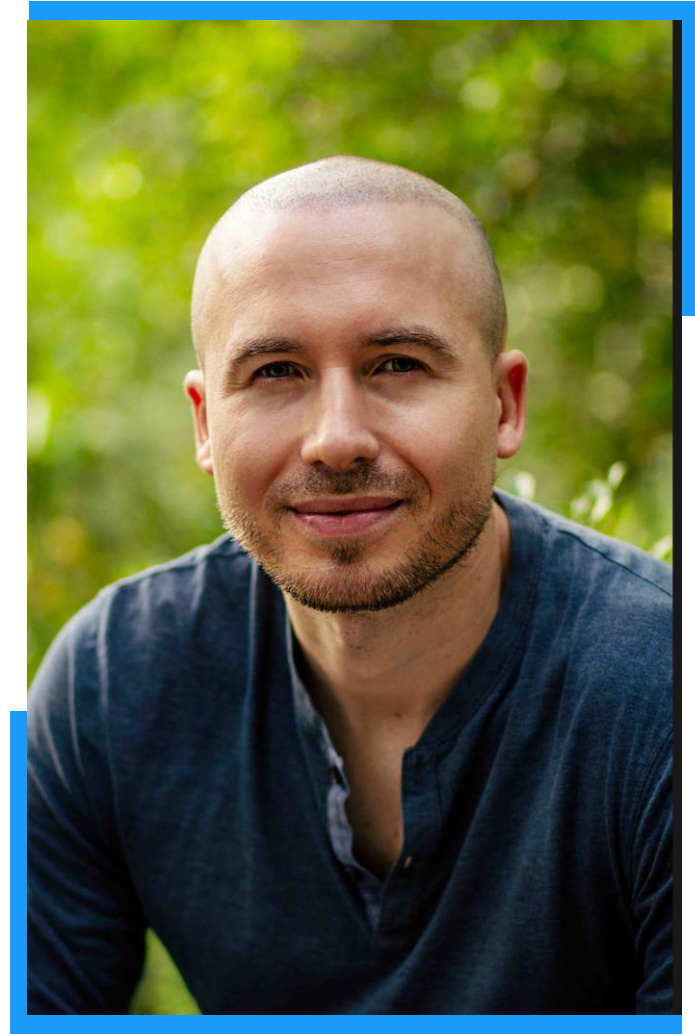


- Tests on a regular basis.

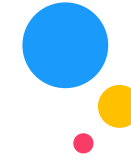


The teacher

Beginning of the course



- You will receive an email inviting you to an initial online interview. This email contains a link to connect to the Zoom software.

During this first interview, you will be given the access codes for the online courses.

- This first interview is designed to determine your level. As a result, an initial evaluation form is completed.



This exchange is also an opportunity to personalize the teaching, according to your needs and objectives (professional, exams: Delf, Tcf...), the time you want to spend, your personal interests (taste for this or that type of learning or method).

Rules



- The individual student must give a minimum of 48 hours notice of absence/delay or the course will be held and considered given. A maximum of three deferrals per month will be tolerated.
